### From the Office of Enrollment Management and Student Life

The new school year is off to an incredible start! The Cottey community is at its best when our new and returning students once again occupy our beautiful campus. Enrollment Management has been so pleased to welcome another stellar class to campus. Here are some hallmarks of the Class of 2027:

- 34% are first generation college students
- The average GPA is 3.47
- · 85% of all new students visited campus before enrolling
- Our new students come from 24 states and 2 countries

It's always exciting to welcome a new group of Cottey students! This is made possible through the hard work of our entire campus community, from welcoming prospective students as they visit campus, to connecting each individual and her family with vital information as they make that important college decision. The campus visit remains our top indicator for future enrollment. A prospective student and her family get to know us best through *Experience Cottey*.

Experience Cottey is an individualized, year-round visit opportunity for high school girls. While on campus, prospective students take a campus tour, meet with admission and financial aid, and can have lunch in Raney Dining Room. Students will also have the option to talk with professors or sit in on a class when available, stop at the Chellie Club for a refreshment at our student snack bar, shop the Spirit Shop, and more. Additionally, any high school senior visiting campus will be eligible for a \$1,500 annual scholarship for up to four years if they enroll, meaning a total scholarship potential of \$6,000! This visit scholarship, paired with our <u>academic scholarships</u>, means that Cottey is increasingly affordable to more prospective students.

Cottey provides a night in a local hotel for students visiting from over 100 miles from campus. We encourage any prospective student wanting to Experience Cottey to begin planning her visit with her enrollment counselor here: <u>www.cottey.edu/visit</u>.

It's never too early to start thinking about next year's class, and YOU can help us grow it!
